## Application Process

## Eligibility Requirements

- Must have financial need as determined by the FAFSA; and,
- Must enroll full-time (at least 12 hours) each semester; and,
- Must be a South Carolina Resident for at least 1 year; and,
- Must meet the applicable academic requirements:
  - Freshmen must have obtained a high school diploma (or equivalent) and be fully admitted as a degree-seeking student
  - Upperclassmen must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress
