

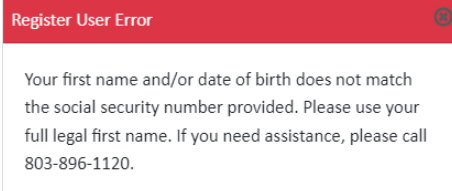
Creating an account

In order to access the *myTG* Student Portal, you must have a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file. The FAFSA is used as the official application for South Carolina Tuition Grants, and you must enter your information exactly as it is on your FAFSA. *Please note, creating an account requires you to enter your full social security number. Always ensure you are on the correct website prior to registering for an account. myTG Student Portal's URL is <https://mytg.guarantorsolutions.com/StudentPortal/>.*

1. Go to <https://mytg.guarantorsolutions.com/StudentPortal/>
2. Click the "If this is your first time accessing the Student Portal..." link to go to the account registration page:



3. Enter your information exactly as it was provided on your FAFSA form
 - a. An error will display if the information does not match the information on file




4. You must select a 'Personal Image' which will display each time you log into your account, and agree to the Terms and Conditions
5. Once your account has been created, you can log in




Logging into the myTG Student Portal

1. Go to <https://mytg.guarantorsolutions.com/StudentPortal/>
2. Enter your username and click **LOG IN**
3. Ensure your personal image is displaying, and enter your password



4. Once logged in, you will see your Student Profile



5. To view your eligibility status and/or award information, you can click on **SC Tuition Grants**. This will display the information based on the applicable Academic Year





Viewing your South Carolina Tuition Grants Eligibility Status

The *myTG* Student Portal allows you to view your South Carolina Tuition Grants application and eligibility status. By clicking on the **SC Tuition Grants** menu (for mobile users, you must click the hamburger button (☰) to access the **SC Tuition Grants** menu), you will be able to view the results of your application, and if tentatively eligible, the amount.



Transferring your South Carolina Tuition Grant

If you will not be attending the college/university listed, you can transfer your South Carolina Tuition Grant to another eligible independent college or university. The full list of eligible colleges and universities can be found [here](#).

Please note: if the college or university you will be attending is not listed, you cannot transfer your SC Tuition Grant there. South Carolina Tuition Grants are available at the 22 participating independent colleges and universities **only**. The public colleges and universities receive funding for the South Carolina Need-Based Grant, which is awarded by the financial aid office at those institutions directly.

1. Log into the myTG Student Portal
2. Under the Student Profile section, click **Change Institution**



4. Select the eligible college or university you wish to transfer your South Carolina Tuition Grant to, and the semester you wish the transfer to be effective (fall or spring)
 - a. Please note the following:
 - i. You can only transfer your grant for terms that have not yet been paid; and,
 - ii. You must be eligible/receiving SC Tuition Grants during the fall to receive the spring portion (please see the Eligibility Requirements for more information); and,
 - iii. Your eligibility may change based on the college/university's Cost of Attendance
5. Click **Save**
6. The page will refresh, and you can now view your eligibility at the new institution by clicking **SC Tuition Grants**
